Who said you can't travel around Lebanon during winter? Culminating at 3088 m altitude, Mount Lebanon will fascinate you in his white covered facet during winter time. From roaming the snowy mountain roads, experiencing the winter activities it has to offer, tasting homemade specialties and stepping foot in some hidden gems of this land, this trip is the ultimate insider travel experience that will show you around our beautiful Lebanon during the winter season.

Along this 9-day route, get ready to Ski with a view on the majestic cedars or in the largest ski resort in the middle east, you'll also be snowshoeing in some pristine landscapes and natural reserves. You will visit some of the country's world heritage sites and learn about its millennial history. To top it all, we handpicked for you some unique lodges and guesthouses in order to have an ultimate winter and cozy experience.

Traveling with us also means traveling ethically with a purpose. This is why within your trip costs you will first be compensating your trip's CO2 emissions by adopting a Cedar tree under your own name! You will be donating to support a local small business or an individual in need of support with Beit el Baraka Ngo working in the rehabilitation of homes and the support of local families by all means since 2020.











How are you contributing to humanity within your trip?

Nature & Ecology: This is a 100% carbon free emission trip. Within this trip fee each participant is donating an amount equal to his/her flights CO2 emissions (international flights) to adopt a cedars in the highlands of Lebanon with Jouzour Loubnan Association. Each participant will receive a certificate of appreciation with the GPS coordinates of the adopted tree under his/her own name.

Local Community: 70% out of the trip cost is directly generating income to the local communities working in the tourism sector, from accommodations to services, activities and small businesses.

Community Service: By assigning to the trip, every traveler is donating 50\$ part of the trip cost, that will be used for supporting families in need under the support of Beit el Baraka organization. The donated budget will help rehabilitate a home, or simply help buy food or basic amenities for families that have been affected by the devastating explosion of August 2020 or the economic crisis. One day within this trip will be reserved for the visit of the NGO and learning about their work and the beneficiary from this initiative. 

Itinerary description:

Day 1: Saturday, February 12

Beirut - (Arrival Day)

- Arrival to Rafic Hariri Airport: Pick up & Assistance
- Time for SIM cards purchase if needed and Money exchange
- Transfer to BAFFA or similar guesthouse in Beirut.
- Armenian welcome diner at Mayrig restaurant.
- Metro al Madina Show (the show details will be announced one month ahead of the trip)

Meals Included: Diner Accommodation: BAFFA or similar Guesthouse in Beirut

Day 2: Sunday, February 13

Beirut – Hadath el Jebbeh - Cedars

- Breakfast at Al Soussi, a typical morning lebanese streetfood.
- Alternative guided tour of Beirut.

Get to know Beirut's socio political landmarks, hidden gems as well as millennial and modern history and stories by walking around its streets and meeting its people.

- Visit and Meet up with the Beit el Baraka NGO team, get to learn about the supported initiative and meet the beneficiary of the local business.
- Drive to Hadath el Jebbeh for a very traditional diner at Ward's in her very own cozy restaurant.

Day 3: Monday, February 14 Cedars

- Full Ski day at the Cedars ski Resort (the oldest ski resort in Lebanon)
- Free evening

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Accommodation: Mountain lodge in the Cedars Day 4: Tuesday, February 15 Chatine – Nahle – Aassia – Byblos – Qanat Bakich

- Visit of Baatara Gorge and its large winter waterfall
- Lunch and wine tasting at Sept a biodynamic winery
- Pass by an ancient pottery maker's Atelier in Aassia
- Sunset visit of the historical ruins & old town of Byblos.

One of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in the world, bearing an exceptional testimony of the Phoenician civilization, and the diffusion of their alphabet

• Drive to Odom retreat in Qanat Bakich

Day 5: Wednesday, February 16

Mzaar/Kfardebian – Qanat Bakich

• Full ski day at the Mzaar ski resort (the largest ski resort in the middle east). Free evening.

Day 6: Thursday, February 17

Bikfaya - Zaarour - Falougha

- Breakfast at Krikor's legendary home-Bakery in Bikfaya.
- Guided Snowshoeing in Zaarour (optional skiing is available at the zaarour ski resort)
- Scenic mountain roadtrip from Zaarour to Falougha
- Diner at local modest ecolodge in Falougha

Meals Included: Breakfast + Diner

Accommodation: Sohat village resort in Falougha (a mountain ecolodge with modest cabins)

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Day 7: Friday, February 18

Baalbek – Riyak – Qab Elias – Ain zhalta

• Visit the Archeological site of Baalbek, the Souks, the Roman Quarry, Palmyra Hotel and the Sayyida Khawla mosque.

Baalbek with its majestic structures, is one of the finest examples of Imperial Roman Architecture at its apogee. Well known as Heliopolis since the Hellenistic Period or the city of the sun for its complex where a triad of deities was worshiped.

- Private traditional lunch at la Vieille cabane in Riyak + wine/arak pairing and tasting from château Rayak winery
- Wine tasting afternoon at château Heritage winery
- Return and diner at la Maison des Sources guesthouse in Ain Zhalta

Meals Included: Breakfast + Lunch + Diner

Accommodation: La Maison des sources guesthouse in Ain Zhalra

Day 8: Saturday, February 19

Barouk – Beiteddine – Deir el Qamar

- Guided Moderate level Snowshoeing in the Barouk Cedars reserve (9 km).
- Traditional Home-made lunch at Cezar's guesthouse.
- Afternoon visit of the Beiteddine Palace and free time at the historical town of Deir el Qamar.
- Diner at Deir el Oumara in Deir el Qamar

Day 9: Sunday, February 20

Beirut (Departure day)

• Return to Beirut for a free day in the capital & airport drop off.
